Farleigh Bridge, East Farleigh

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow level crossing maintenance and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Farleigh Bridge, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 23rd July 2022 at 23:00, with estimated completion by 25th July 2022 at 05:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL820PWS1-42-73-230722-02 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Farleigh Bridge will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing maintenance and other associated works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for traffic travelling northbound is via Station Hill, B2010 Lower Road, Dean Street, Farleigh Hill, Tovil Hill, Tovil Road, College Road, A229 College Road, Mill Street, Bishops Way, A20 The Broadway, A26 Tonbridge Road and Farleigh Lane.

The alternative route for traffic travelling southbound is via Farleigh Lane, A26 Tonbridge Road, A20 Terrace Road, London Road, The Broadway, A229 St Peter's Bridge, Fairmeadow, Bishops Way, Palace Avenue, Lower Stone Street, Upper Stone Street, Sheals Crescent, Old Tovil Road, B2010 Tovil Road, Tovil Hill, Farleigh Hill, Dean Street, Lower Road and Station Hill.
