Various Roads, Maidstone

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER SEPTEMBER 2022

To allow gas main replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Maidstone.

Closures are planned from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 8th November 2022. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

Farleigh Lane, Maidstone

Farleigh Lane will be closed from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd October 2022.

The road will be closed in three phases between the junctions with A26 Tonbridge Road and Farleigh Bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route during phase 1 is via A26 Tonbridge Road and Glebe Lane.

The alternative route during phase 2 & 3 is via Farleigh Bridge, Station Hill, Lower Road, Teston Lane, A26 Tonbridge Road and Glebe Lane.

Glebe Lane, Maidstone

Glebe Lane will be closed from 3rd October 2022, with estimated completion by 8th November 2022.

The road will be closed in two phases between the junctions with A26 Tonbridge Road and Farleigh Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for both phases is via A26 Tonbridge Road and Farleigh Lane.

Rectory Lane, Barming

Rectory Lane will be closed from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 8th November 2022.

The road will be closed in two phases between the junctions with Glebe Lane and Farleigh Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route during phase 1 & 2 is via Farleigh Lane and Glebe Lane.

Farleigh Bridge, East Farleigh

Farleigh Bridge will be closed from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd October 2022.

The road will be closed between Farleigh Lane and Station Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Station Hill, Lower Road, Teston Lane, A26 Tonbridge Road, Glebe Lane and Farleigh Lane.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main replacement works are undertaken by SGN.
