Gallants Lane, East Farleigh

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2022

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gallants Lane, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 30th October 2022 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 30th October 2022 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS362918-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Gallants Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Furminger House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Gallants Lane, B2010 Lower Road, Ewell Lane, B2163 Heath Road and vice versa.
