(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2022

To allow gas main replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in East Farleigh & Maidstone.

A closure is planned from 21st November 2022, with estimated completion by 12th January 2023. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The works will be carried out in phases, as detailed below.

Farleigh Lane, Maidstone

Phase 1 - from 21st November 2022, with estimated completion by 21st December 2022.

The road will be closed between the junctions with A26 Tonbridge Road and Glebe Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 2 - from 5th December 2022, with estimated completion by 12th January 2023.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Station Hill and Rectory Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for both phases is via A26 Tonbridge Road, Glebe Lane and vice versa.

Station Hill, East Farleigh

Station Hill will be closed from 5th December 2022, with estimated completion by 12th January 2023.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Lower Road and Farleigh Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Lower Road, Teston Lane, A26 Tonbridge Road, Glebe Lane, Farleigh Lane and Farleigh Bridge.

River Close, East Farleigh

River Close will be closed from 5th December 2022, with estimated completion by 12th January 2023.

The road will be closed between the junction with Station Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end.

However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas main replacement works are undertaken by SGN.
