(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2023

To allow pole inspection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dean Street, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 24th January 2023 at 09:00, with estimated completion by 24th January 2023 at 16:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS444684-06 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Dean Street will be closed between the junctions with Forge Lane and Workhouse Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole inspection works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dean Street, B2163 Heath Road, B2010 Ewell Lane, Lower Road and vice versa.
