Farleigh Lane, Maidstone

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2023

To allow replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Farleigh Lane, Maidstone.

A closure is planned from 22nd May 2023, for up to one night, between the hours of 19.00 and 05.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT12479691-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Farleigh Lane will be closed in the vicinity of number 82, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic:-

- 1 A26 Tonbridge Road, Terrace Road, A20 London Road, A229 St Peters Bridge, A229 Bishops Way, Palace Avenue, Lower Stone Street, Upper Stone Street, Sheals Crescent, B2010 Old Tovil Road, B2010 Farleigh Hill, B2010 Lower Road, Station Hill.
- 2 Station Hill, B2010 Lower Road, B2010 Farleigh Hill, B2010 Old Tovil Road, A229 Hayle Road, College Road, Bishops Way, Broadway, A20 Tonbridge Road, A26 Tonbridge Road, Farleigh Lane.
