Charlton Lane, West Farleigh
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2023

To allow replacement pole works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Charlton Lane, West Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 24th July 2023, with estimated completion by 25th July 2023, between the hours of 09.30 and 15.30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411WDL3H8L001-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Charlton Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Pickering, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement pole works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Charlton Lane, Ewell Lane, Lower Road and vice versa.
