(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2023

To allow duct works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dean Street, Maidstone.

A closure is planned from 24th July 2023, with estimated completion by 7th August 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (UY001EFAR-PIA-DEANSTRRC-02 - Trooli). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Dean Street will be closed from the junction with Forge Lane to the junction with Workhouse Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while duct works are undertaken by Trooli Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dean Street, Heath Road, Linton Road, Loose Road, Sheals Crescent, Old Tovil Road, Tovil Road, Tovil Hill, Farleigh Hill, Dean Street and vice versa.
