TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2023

UK POWER NETWORKS WORKS

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dean Street, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 6th November 2023, with estimated completion by 10th November 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50010252351-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Dean Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Hazeldene, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while electrical connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dean Street, B2163 Heath Road, B2163 Ewell Lane, B2010 Lower Road, Dean Street and vice versa.
