(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2024

South East Water works.

To allow replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dean Street, East Farleigh.

A closure is planned from 9th January 2024, with estimated completion by 10th January 2024, between the hours of 19.00 and 06.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00646438789-05 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Dean Street will be closed in the vicinity of 2 Culls Farm Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Dean Street, B2010 Lower Road, B2163 Ewell Lane, B2163 Heath Road, Dean Street and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
