



Gas Network Upgrade – Vicarage Lane, East Farleigh

We're preparing to carry out essential gas network upgrades in Vicarage Lane, East Farleigh. This work will ensure a continued safe and reliable supply of gas is delivered to nearby homes and businesses. This is part of our 30-year programme of work to replace our old mains, reaching the end of their useful lives, with new, reliable plastic pipe.

Our contractor, I&G Contracting, who are completing this project on our behalf, will be starting work in the week beginning 1 April. We expect this project to last for approximately two weeks.

To ensure everyone's safety, we'll need to close Vicarage Lane around our worksite.

We'll be replacing the pipes along Vicarage Lane from outside numbers 1 to 14. We've arranged to carry out this work during the school holidays due to the proximity to East Farleigh Primary School.

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be kept for residents and businesses.

We're writing to residents and other local stakeholders to explain the details of this work. This letter can be shared with anyone you feel may have an interest in our work.

We understand roadworks can be frustrating. However, the new plastic pipe has a lifespan of 80 years. This means that once our work is done, East Farleigh residents and businesses will be able to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable supply of gas for many years to come.
