



Gas Network Upgrade – Dean Street, East Farleigh

We're preparing to return to complete our essential gas network upgrades in Dean Street, East Farleigh. This work will ensure a continued safe and reliable supply of gas is delivered to nearby homes and businesses. This is part of our 30-year programme of work to replace our old mains, reaching the end of their useful lives, with new, reliable plastic pipe.

Our contractor, I&G Contracting, who are carrying out this project on our behalf, will return to complete the final work to upgrade our network in the week beginning 24 July. We expect this work to take approximately five to six weeks.

To ensure everyone's safety we'll need to close the following roads around the work site while we have excavations open.

- Forge Lane – From 24 July with an estimated end date of 11 August. We'll be working at the junction with Dean Street.
- Dean Street – From 24 July with an estimated end date of 30 August. We'll be working from the junction with Forge Lane to outside White Lion House.

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be kept for residents and businesses.

We're writing to residents and other local stakeholders to explain the details of this work. This letter can be shared with anyone you feel may have an interest in our work.

We understand roadworks can be frustrating. However, the new plastic pipe has a lifespan of 80 years. This means that once our work is done, East Farleigh residents and businesses will be able to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable supply of gas for many years to come.
